WHAT HAS BEEN DONE TO DATE ?

Waste Disposition

- Under Cold Shutdown, 22 rail cars and 47 tanker truck loads of transformer and lubricating oils have been removed and shipped to an offsite treatment facility.
- More than 2,900 tons of excess uranium has been removed from the site.
- From 2003 to 2010, about 78,000 cubic yards of legacy waste were removed from the site.
- In 2011, more than 1,442,000 cubic yards of clean, radioactive, hazardous, and mixed wastes have been shipped off-site.
- More than 1/3 of the mixed hazardous waste inventory has been shipped off-site for treatment.
- DOE met its first milestone ahead of schedule for shipment and treatment of mixed waste off-site via chemical stabilization. DOE is accountable to Ohio EPA for meeting the milestone schedule.
